WHEREAS: The Board of Trustees of Austintown Township has determined that the following properties constitute a public nuisance pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 505.87:

3888 Ascot Court

Parcel No. 48-004-0-065.000

A large amount of miscellaneous items; junk and debris including plant pots and construction materials stored in an exposed manner throughout the property;

75 Evans

Parcel No. 48-027-0-235.000

A large amount of junk and debris stored in an exposed manner throughout the yard area including a dilapidated shed creating a safety issue;

2064 Innwood Drive

Parcel No. 48-107-0-029.000

Piles of broken tree limbs and branches in an exposed manner in rear yard;

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1851 South Turner Road

Parcel No. 48-094-0-028.000

A large amount of miscellaneous items junk and debris stored in an exposed manner including tools and construction materials;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Trustees of Austintown Township that the above referenced properties constitute public nuisances and the property owners are hereby **ORDERED** to abate, control, or remove said nuisances. If said nuisances are not abated, controlled or provision for abatement, control, or removal is not made within **SEVEN (7) DAYS** from the below date of adoption, the **BOARD OF TRUSTEES** will provide for the abatement, control, or removal, and any expenses incurred-**\$500 minimum**-by the Board of Trustees in performing that task will be entered upon the tax duplicate and will be a lien upon the land from the date of entry.

5742 Baylor Avenue - An inoperable Buick with three flat tires parked in an exposed manner at the property; and

2491 Deborah Court – An inoperable and unlicensed vehicle parked in an exposed manner on the grass within the rear yard.


