The Austintown Fire Department (AFD) is accepting applications to form a "Full-Time Hiring List" for the position of Paramedic/Firefighter which will be used for anticipated future employment openings. This list will remain in effect until July 1, 2023.

The AFD is a combination Department made up of 28 full-time and 20 part-time/volunteer Firefighters. Austintown is a suburban community of 38,000 residents. AFD operates two full-time stations and 2 part-time/volunteer stations. All full-time Paramedic/Firefighters fall under a collective bargaining agreement and are members of the IAFF. The starting annual wage is \$43,277.69 plus a \$2,000 Paramedic annual bonus with options of comp. time, benefits and overtime opportunities. - ❖ Candidates must possess a current Ohio Paramedic Certification at time of hire
- ❖ Candidates must obtain an Ohio Firefighter II Certification within one year of their hire date

Candidates must be in good physical condition and be able to pass all pre-employment screenings including, but not limited to, physical examination, background checks and drug screening. All candidates will be required to present an active verification of a "passing time" on the Firefighter Physical Agility Test (PAT) conducted by the Cuyahoga Community College (Tri-C) in Parma Ohio. The maximum test completion time required is "**4 minutes 30 seconds**". It is the candidate's responsibility to schedule and pay for the PAT through Tri C.
